- Develop a comprehensive understanding of storage, data and datacenter components and their roles in modern IT infrastructure.
- Acquire familiarity with major cloud service providers and develop an understanding of the security and privacy considerations inherent in cloud computing.
- Analyse and articulate the ITSM lifecycle and ITIL practices with an understanding of how IT services are delivered and managed within an organization.
- Explore the key processes and methodologies used to identify, track, and resolve IT incidents and problems that includes incident response, troubleshooting techniques, and root cause analysis.
- Evaluate and recognise several useful aspects of ITSM that emphasise the overall learning value.
