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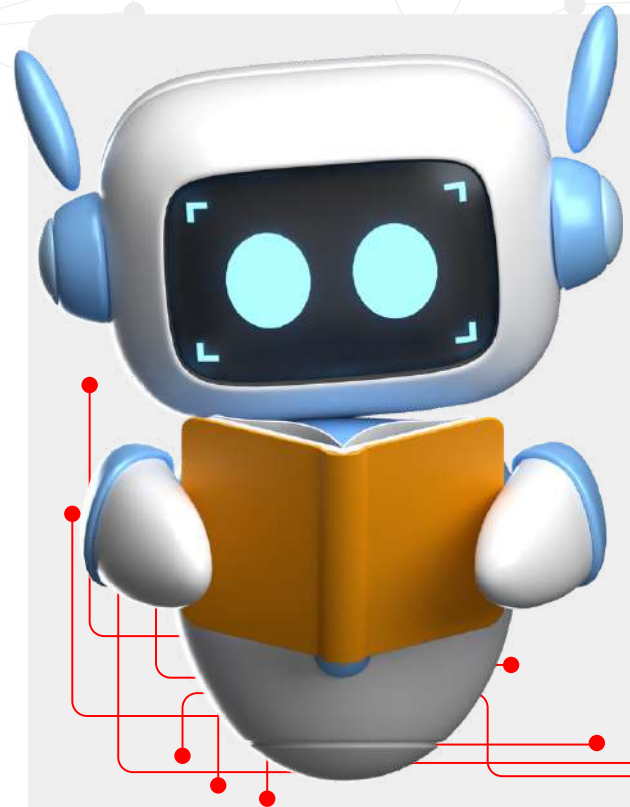

Programme Synopsis

The Diploma in Generative AI is a comprehensive, hands-on programme designed to equip working professionals across business functions with the practical knowledge and technical fluency to harness Generative AI tools for real world problem-solving and innovation.

Comprising seven modules: Sales & Marketing, HR, Finance, Business Intelligence, Inventory, Operations, and a Capstone; the programme integrates key tools such as **ChatGPT**, **Microsoft Copilot**, and **DeepSeek**, with domain-specific applications in **automation**, **forecasting**, **analytics**, and **workflow optimisation**. Participants will learn to apply AI ethically and responsibly, design effective prompts, evaluate model outputs, and adapt AI solutions to meet diverse business needs. Each module focuses on task-relevant applications, such as **campaign automation**, **manpower planning**, **financial reporting**, or **supply chain visibility**, while the Capstone enables learners to develop and present AI-driven solutions tailored to their workplace.

This diploma is ideal for professionals, managers, and SME owners who seek to develop AI integration skills without requiring a programming background. Through case studies, guided projects, and collaborative learning, graduates will be empowered to lead digital transformation initiatives and drive sustainable business value through the application of AI innovation.

Entry Requirements

Language Proficiency:

- Attained at least WPLN Level 6, OR
- Obtained Grade C6 for GCE O Level English, OR
- Other equivalent qualifications

Academic Qualifications:

- Obtained at least a pass or C6 at GCE O-level in at least 3 subjects, OR
- Candidates with other qualifications will be considered on a case-by-case basis, OR
- Mature candidates (30 years old and above) with at least 8 years of relevant working experience

Course-Specific Prerequisites:

The AI Capstone Project (Module 7) requires prior completion of all six specialist modules (Modules 1 to 6). Participants must have completed all prerequisite modules before enrolling in the Capstone Project.

Each module is assessed through one or more of the following assessment types, selected to match the knowledge and skills being developed:

- **Written Assessment** — Tests conceptual understanding, regulatory frameworks, governance principles, and analytical reasoning.
- **Practical Assessment** — Evaluates hands-on proficiency through task-based exercises using AI tools and structured workflows in realistic business scenarios.
- **Oral Assessment** — Used in the AI Capstone Project to assess communication, project reasoning, data storytelling, and professional judgement.

Assessment hours are included within each module's total training hours. Participants must achieve a passing mark in each module's assessment to receive the relevant module certificate and progress to the Capstone Project.

- ✓ Design and implement AI-powered workflows across sales, marketing, HR, finance, operations, inventory management, and business intelligence functions

- ✓ Leverage predictive analytics, sentiment analysis, and data storytelling to translate AI outputs into compelling executive narratives and board-ready reports
- ✓ Develop domain-specific AI transformation roadmaps and implementation plans with clear milestones and measurable ROI
- ✓ Design, build, validate, and present a production-ready Generative AI module tailored to a real organisational context

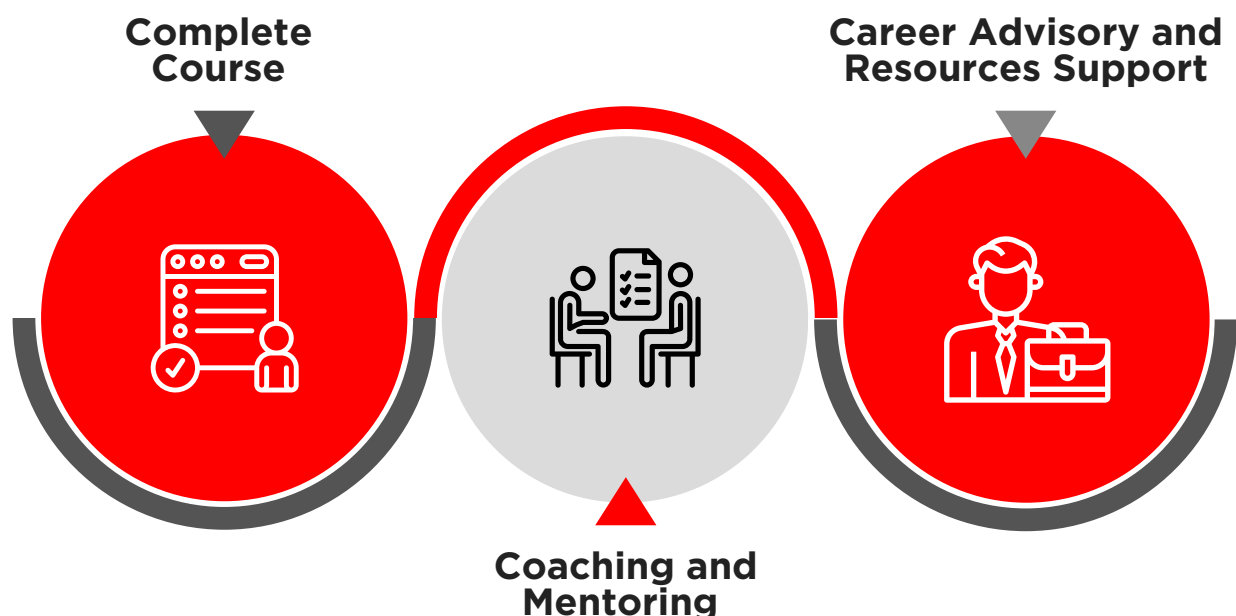
